The events in Holmenkollen are part of the FIS World Cup in Ski Jumping, Nordic Combined and Cross-Country. The ski jumping competitions start off with qualifications for men on Friday 13 March, and competitions for both women and men Saturday and Sunday. On Saturday, for the first time ever, both men and women will race the 50 km mass start simultaneously. This double 50 km format brings a fresh and exciting dynamic to the course: both genders will be on the trail at the same time, creating a truly historic moment in Holmenkollen's tradition. On Sunday the program features Ski Jumping and Nordic Combined throughout the day. Overall, it promises to be a weekend full of dramatic moments, blending Holmenkollen's rich tradition with a bold new concept.
